centralized project appraisal

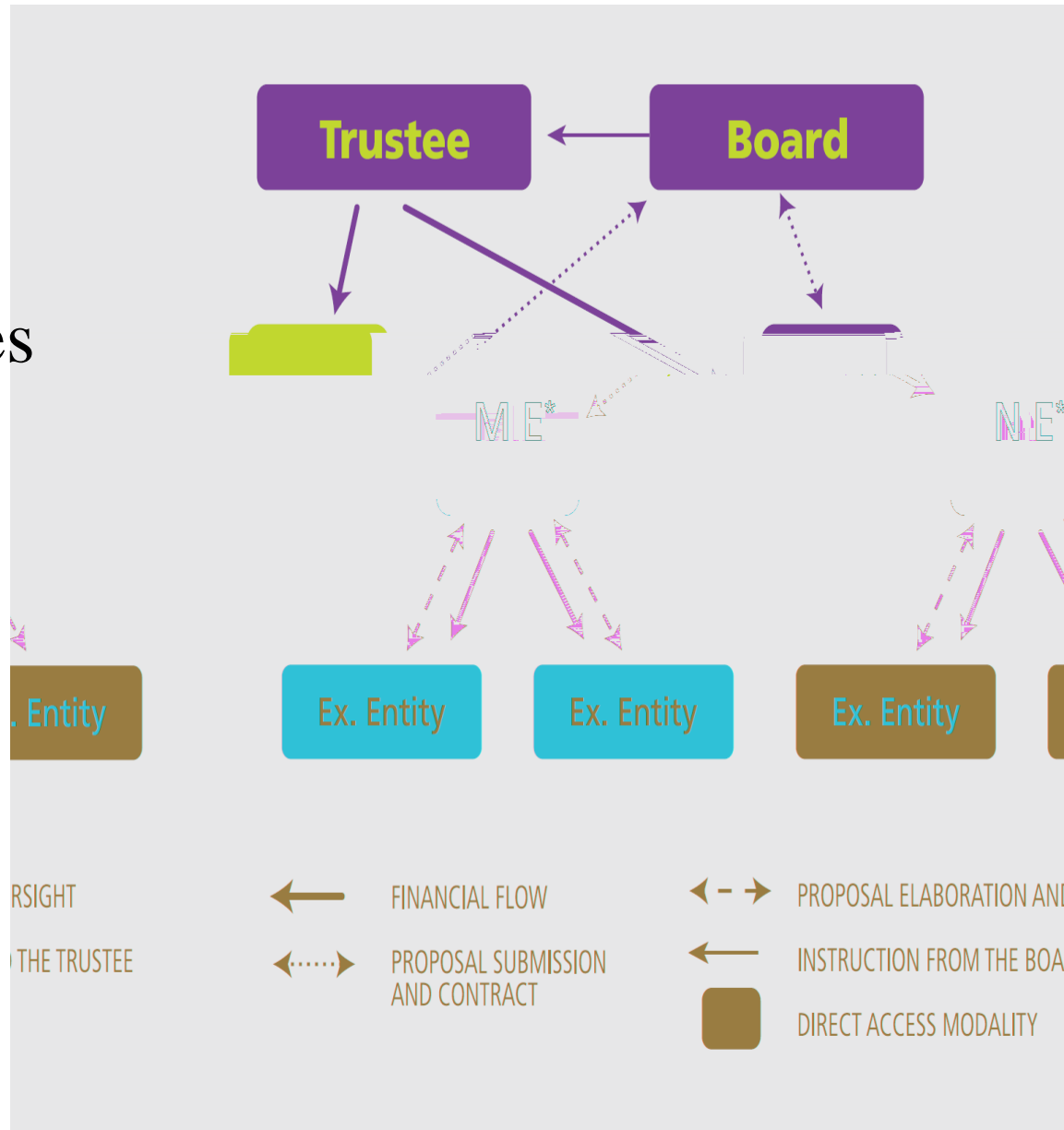

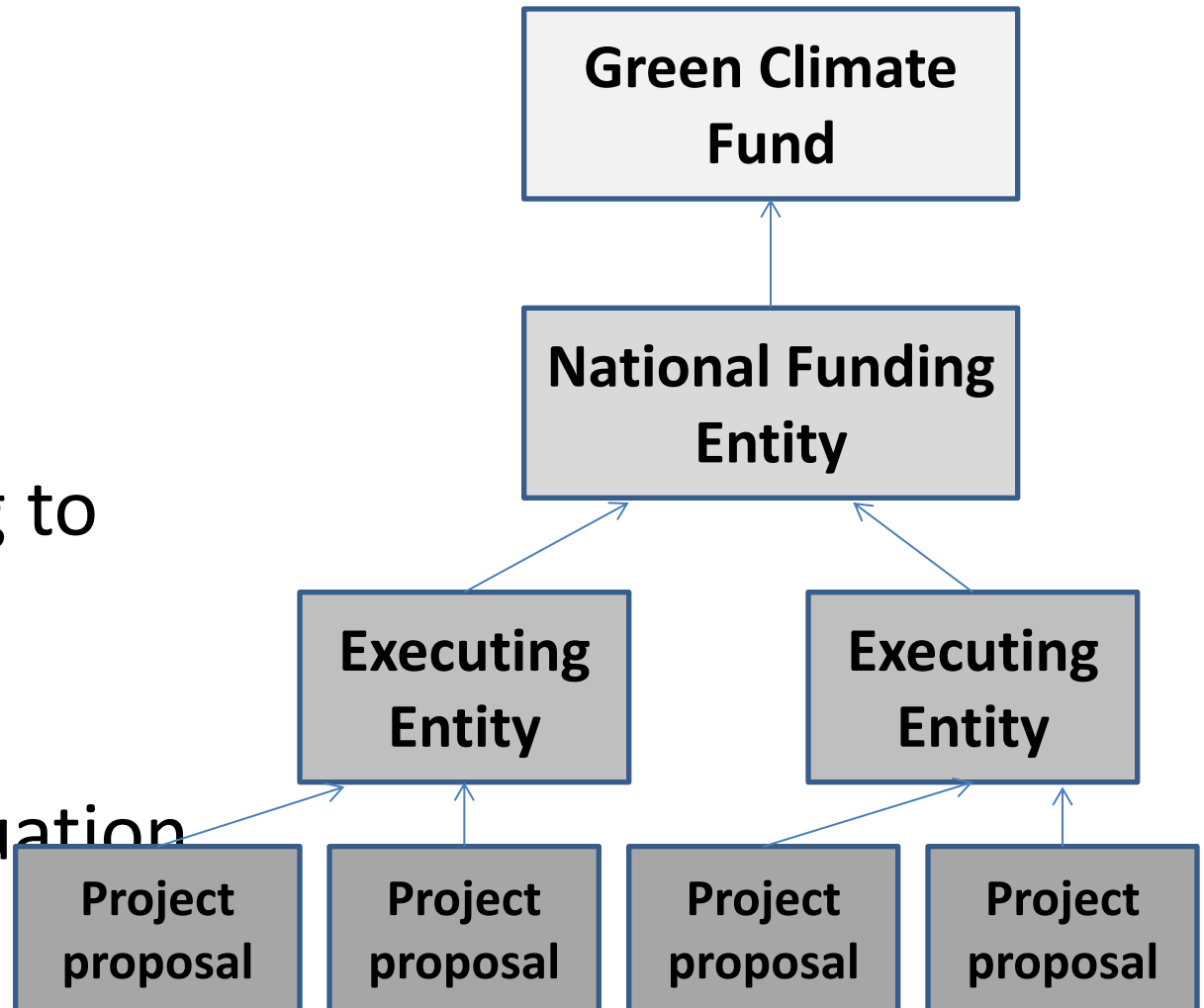


# ENHANCED DIRECT ACCESS

## Country Ownership

**National Funding Entities:** legal national institutions accredited by the GCF Board to perform functions of evaluation, approval and disbursement of funds

**National Designated Authority:** for provision of no-objection to ensure consistency with national strategies and priorities
