


Overview

- In Sharm el-Sheikh Parties established a work programme on just transition for discussion of pathways to achieving the goals of the Paris Agreement outlined in Article 2, paragraph 1, in the context of Article 2, paragraph 2 (para 52 I/CMA.4)
- In the same decision (paras 50 and 51), Parties affirmed that sustainable and just solutions to the climate crisis must be **founded on meaningful and effective social dialogue and participation of all stakeholders** and noted that the **global transition to low emissions provides opportunities and challenges for sustainable economic development and poverty eradication**.
- Also, this decision highlighted that a just and equitable transition encompasses pathways that include energy, socioeconomic, workforce and other dimensions, all of which must be based on nationally defined development priorities and include social protection to mitigate potential impacts associated with the transition.
- As part of this work programme (para 53), the CMA will also convene an annual high-level ministerial round table on just transition, beginning at CMA5 in Dubai.


What should be the main elements of JTWP that could be agreed in Dubai?



- At least an overarching decision with main elements to allow the work to start
 - similar to MWP
- Scope given in para 52 I/CMA.4 (discussion of pathways to achieving the goals of the Paris Agreement outlined in Article 2, paragraph I, in the context of Article 2, paragraph 2)
- Objective improve understanding and enhance equity and climate ambition
- Function share knowledge (including best available science), best practices, lessons learned and experience relevant to just transition pathways
- Modalities timeframe, co-chairs, number of meetings, submissions on discussion topics
- Inputs and outputs

Has to be linked to the Paris Agreement and Sharm el-Sheikh Implementation Plan:

- PA: 'Taking into account the imperatives of a just transition of the workforce and the creation of decent work and quality jobs in accordance with nationally defined development priorities' - one of the focus areas on workforces in national transitions
- Social dialogue and participation of all stakeholders
- Social protection to mitigate potential impacts associated with national transition pathways
- Sectoral approach including energy, socioeconomic, workforce and other dimensions


What should be the role and outcome of the annual high-level ministerial round table on just transition?

- Deliver guidance to Parties that can be used in their climate policies and for technical discussions
- Create political momentum for accelerating implementation of the Paris Agreement
