KEY NEGOTIATION PRIORITIES FOR COP 25

- **Ambition** - Raising headline ambition to limit temperature rise to 1.5°C
- **Carbon markets** - Article 6 rules and guidance that increase global mitigation ambition, prevent accounting loopholes and generate increased support to the Adaptation Fund
- **Climate finance** – mobilizing increased external support for adaptation and mitigation initiatives, and continue discussions on Long Term Finance towards launching negotiations, and arrangements and governance of the Adaptation Fund.
- **Loss and Damage** - innovative approaches and greater financial and technical support, resulting from Warsaw International Mechanism (WIM) Review
- **Continuing technical negotiations elaborating rulebook:** NDC common time frames, adaptation communications and methodologies, operational details of the enhanced transparency framework (ETF).
- **Other items:** institutional arrangements and mandate for the Paris Agreement Committee on Capacity Building (PCCB), terms of reference of the Consultative Group of Experts (CGE)
