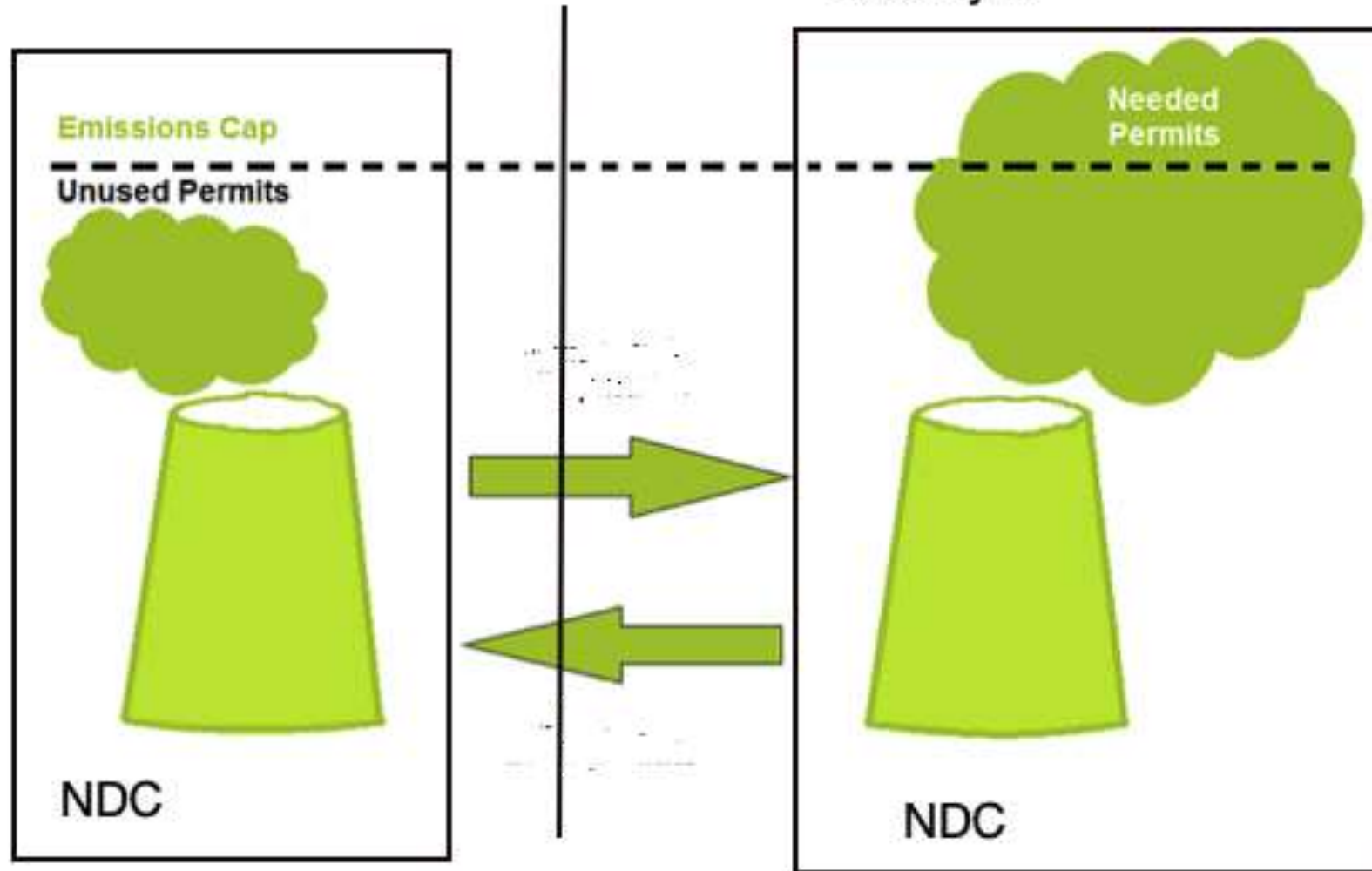

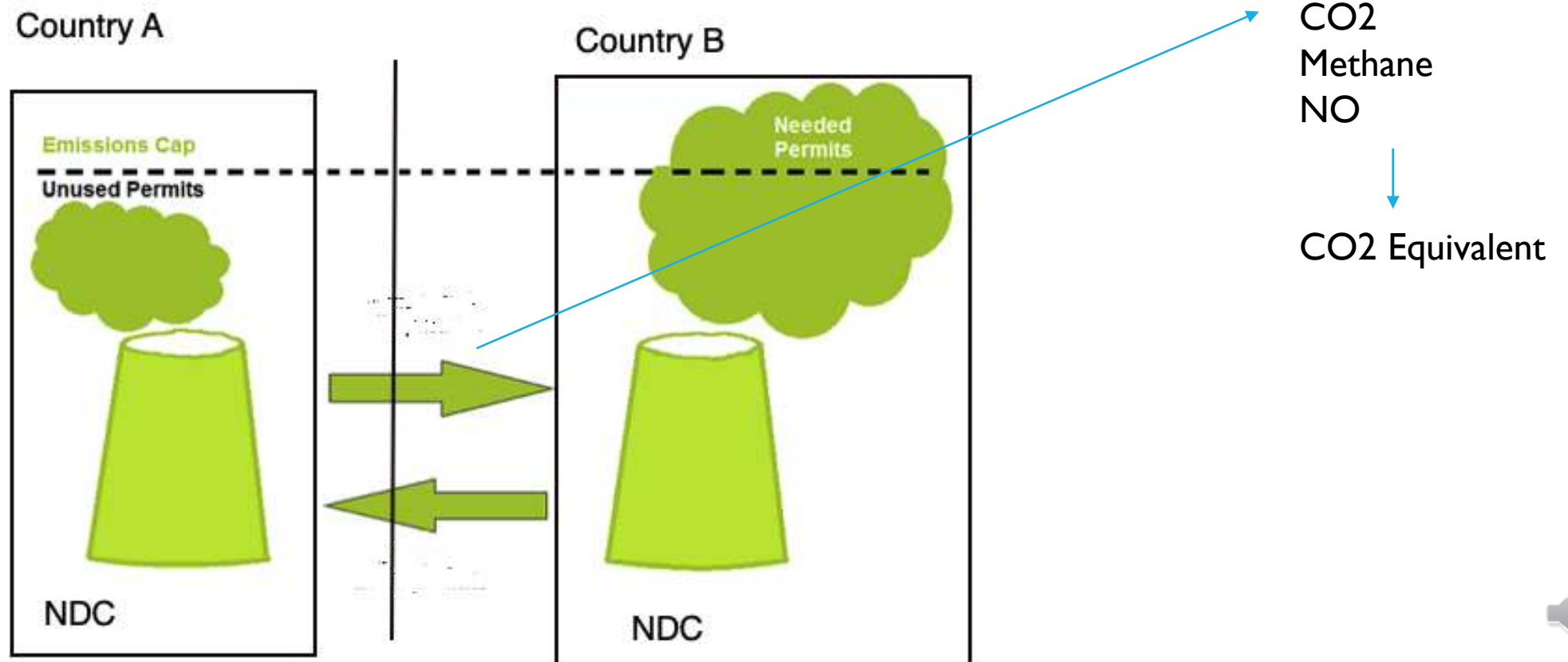

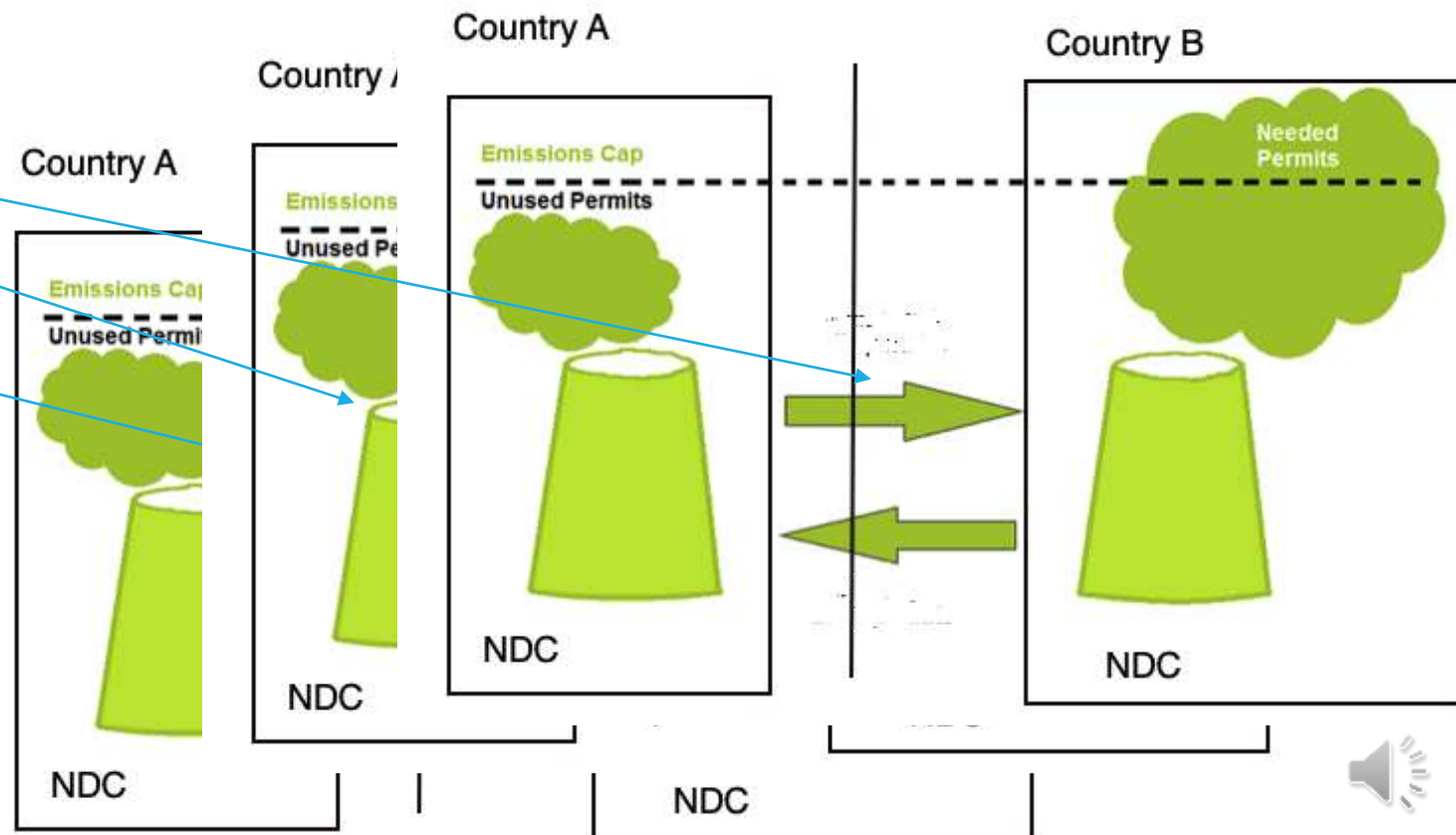
# ISSUES TO BE ADDRESSED BY COP25

- I. **Definitions:** ITMOs: real, measured and measured in a tonnes of CO2 equivalent, include mitigation outcomes from Art 6.4



# ISSUES TO BE ADDRESSED BY COP25

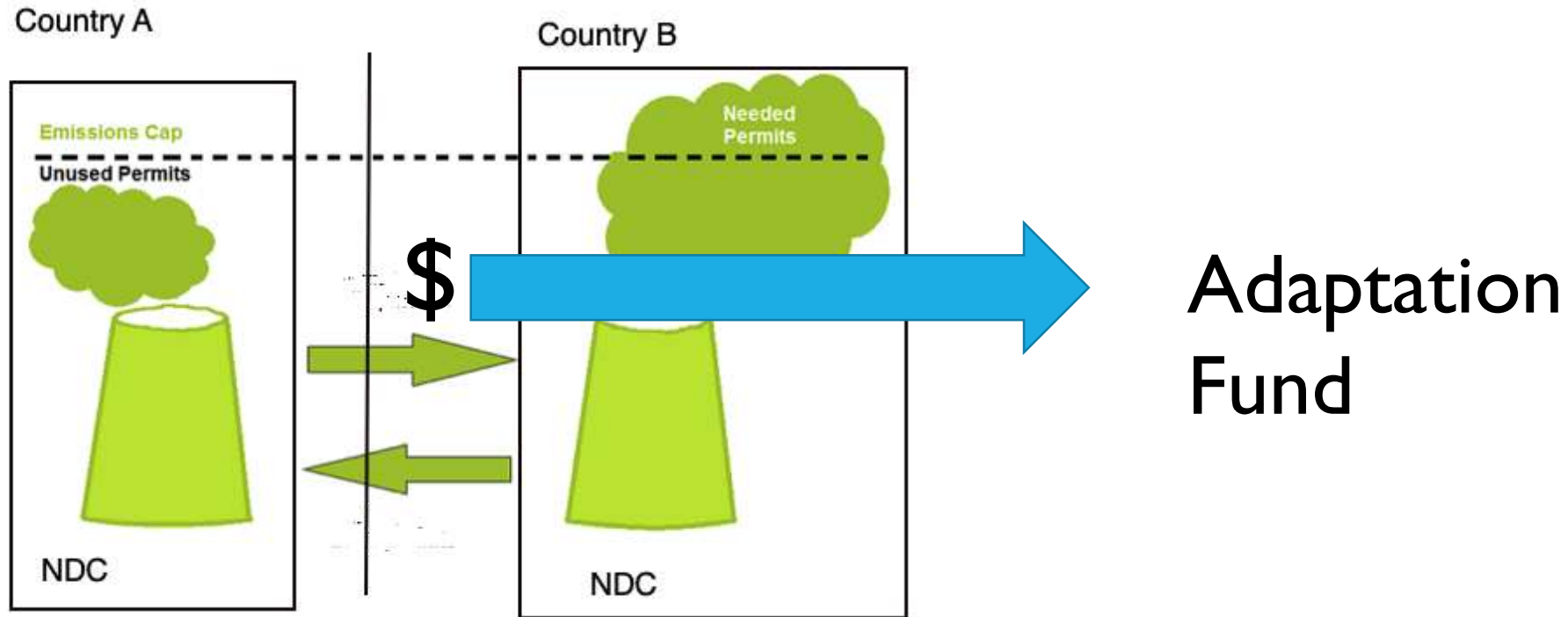
- Tracking:** Each Party [as well as the Article 6 database] shall ensure tracking and identification of ITMOs including first transfer, transfer, acquisition, holding, use, voluntary cancellation, cancellation for overall mitigation in global emissions, share of proceeds for adaptation
